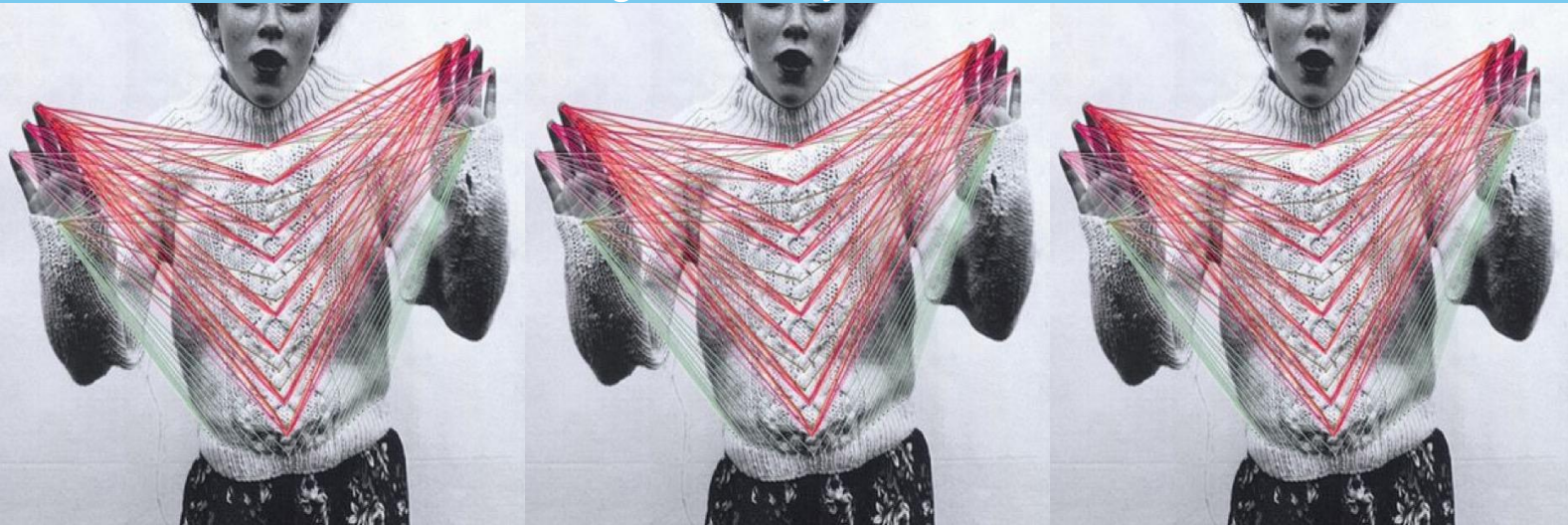


Call for Expressions of Interest
CHC42015 CERTIFICATE IV in COMMUNITY SERVICES
For Existing Community Services Workers



Are you currently working in the community services sector and have valuable skills,
but no qualification to match?

WAYS Youth Training is asking for expressions of interest from workers who have sector experience and would be interested in gaining a Certificate IV in Community Services.

WHAT & WHO: CHC42015 Certificate IV in Community Services as a professional development and networking opportunity for existing community services workers or those who have sector experience

WHERE: WAYS Youth & Family Bondi Junction

DATES: Anticipated start date of October 2017 (exact date TBC) for approximately 18 weeks

TIMES: Every Saturday, 9am – 5pm

COST: The normal cost for a Certificate IV course is \$6000; however, WYT has access to some subsidised funding under the Smart and Skilled program. This can mean, depending on your circumstances, you could be fully funded or only required to pay up to \$2320. As a suggestion, your employers may be prepared to subsidise this as part of your professional development.

WHAT CAN STUDENTS ACHIEVE FROM THE COURSE?

Students can achieve CHC42015 Certificate IV in Community Services. This includes 15 Units of Competency (UOC) covering key skills and knowledge required for entry-level community services work. This training will also solidify existing skills and knowledge for those who hold current or previous community services experience.

THE COURSE ALSO INCLUDES:

- Project based work and networking with peers
- Career guidance and working on individual experience, skills and strengths
- Assistance with application to work environment including site visit to workplace, or assistance with job support as required
- Links to further education and training pathways

- Relevant guest speakers as needed covering a range of fields (youth, aged care, disability, Indigenous, CALD, and more)

WHO ARE WAYS YOUTH TRAINING?

WAYS Youth Training (WYT) is a registered training organisation (RTO) that specialises in interactive and practical courses for young people and those supporting young people. Completion rates are consistently over 75%.

WYT is an official alternative education program approved by the Board of Studies. Students can transfer from school from 15 years of age. WYT courses are also Centrelink approved.

WYT (RTO 90114) has delivered Nationally Recognised Qualifications to 15-24 year olds since 2009. It is part of WAYS Youth & Family, which also provides support services to young people in health, mental health, case management and recreation for assistance with personal issues.
