A WAYS Safe Summer is a **casual** summer job. If you are successful in the application you will be asked to work **as required**. We understand school students are unavailable during school hours. **During Feb-April 2018**, some shifts may be after school hours from 4pm onwards, but mostly on Saturdays during the school term. Otherwise most shifts are during the Dec/Jan holidays. WAYS closes for approximately 2 weeks in Dec – Jan from Dec 22nd-Jan 7th, so there will not be any shifts during this time.
