PROGRAM COSTS & WHAT'S INCLUDED

Our standard daily rate includes all in-house clubs, afternoon tea, rooftop play, inclusive support, and supervision.

Some activities include a small additional cost to cover materials or specialist instructors. These are always shown clearly during booking.

ADDITIONAL ACTIVITY CHARGES (IF SELECTED)

A Feature Day

is an After School Care session where your child can join us for the usual permanent booking fee and the scheduled activity for that session is included at no extra cost.

- Only pay the usual After School Care session fee
- The special activity is included — no additional charge
- CCS (Child Care Subsidy) applies if eligible
- No ongoing commitment

BUSINESS CLUB

Create. Build. Pitch.

Kids become mini entrepreneurs as they develop a product or service, build branding and signage, learn pricing and budgeting, and pitch their idea at a live Market Day.

COOKING CLUB

MasterChef-style learning in the kitchen

Children learn everything from food safety to salad making, baking, stir-fry, and global dishes. The term ends with a signature dish presentation.

SOCCER SKILLS WITH EASTS FC

Train like a junior pro

Delivered in partnership with Easts Football Club, this program builds confidence, coordination, and game technique through weekly skill-based sessions.

BOXING CLUB WITH BONDI BOXING GYM

Fitness, focus, and confidence

Non-contact boxing drills delivered by professional coaches from Bondi Boxing Gym. Children learn movement, discipline, and fitness in a safe environment.

GRAFFITI ART AND CREATIVE DESIGN

Expressive art with real-world tools

Kids work with artists to create bold, large-scale art using mixed media, stencils, and illustration techniques. Includes a showcase to display their work.

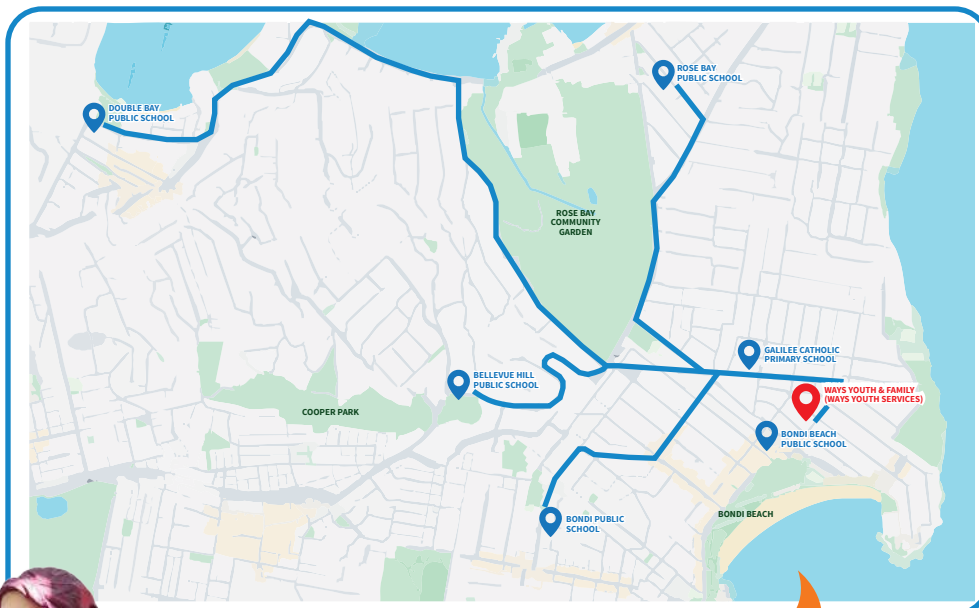
